Talk Title: "<u>Props for the Memory and Doing Wrong in the Work of Joseph Beuys</u>" By Duke University's **Kristine Stiles**

No other artist of the twentieth century who engaged in war on that side of doing wrong has been as celebrated as German artist Joseph Beuys. In an unprecedented examination of the way Beuys' iconography relates to National Socialism, Stiles suggests that Beuys used his art as "a prop for the memory " of the Third Reich.
