Born in Belfast, Northern Ireland and living in London since 1980, Stitt is considered one of the UK's foremost art performance creators. He has worked as a live artist since 1977, producing over 250 unique performances at major galleries, festivals, alternative venues and public spaces throughout the UK, Europe, North America and his native Ireland. Stitt currently runs the program Time Based Art at the Cardiff School of Art.
