ITEM IV: PROPOSALS FOR COMPOST BIN SALES.


The memo dated March 03, 1993 from the Project Technician was reviewed and following consideration it was recommended and approved that 3 businesses be chosen to distribute home composters. (David Hunter, Art Knapp and Reids Hardware) All other recommendations were approved. It was noted that Port Moody will not be proceeding with any home composter sales this year.

The committee discussed the home composting program and enquired as to the success and effectiveness of the 1992 program. It was recommended that a questionnaire be sent to 150 to 200 last years purchasers of composters. Questions could include: use, volume, number purchased, type of material composted, comments, questions etc. Results of such a questionnaire will be reported back to committee when available.

ITEM V: CITY COMPOSTING OPTIONS.

The committee reviewed the memo from the Project Engineer dated March 15, 1993. Following discussion it was requested that additional information on cost be provided and considered at the next committee meeting.




ITEM VI: OTHER BUSINESS.
