ITEM I: POST LITTER CLEAN-UP CAMPAIGN 1987 DISCUSSIONS

T. Chong advised the Committee that he will be writing the Chairman of the Committee to obtain more information.


ITEM III: DEFERRED BUSINESS


The Committee wishes to include the following items for discussion at the next EPC meeting to be held at 4:00 p.m. May 21, 1987.
