A resident has requested that we remove the George Pearkes lacrosse box due to noise etc.


Recommendation:

Associated Engineering have confirmed the total available area in Reeve Park, within their new dyke.

It covers the area direct west of the grass soccerfield, south side till it meets the dyke, and also includes some of the already cleared B.M.X track. The total is 7.59 hectares, which converts to 18.74 acres.

Subtracting the slope of the inside dyke and the track we end up with 17 acres

At a very good cost (according to A E) of \$ 2.500 per acre , our total clearing cost would be \$ 42.500.
