Janna presented two conceptual plans which Bill Geiss, an architect, has drawn up for the Parks & Recreation Department. The costs for construction for the two conceptual plans ranged from \$219,000 to \$259,000. The Committee felt that the plans were far too elaborate for McLean Park. It was agreed that the architect would be asked to scale down his proposal drastically.

Recommendation:

That Bill Geiss be directed to scale down the conceptual plans to a more realistic cost that would be acceptable to the Committee.

Janna went briefly over the contract. The changes recommended by the solicitor have now been incorporated.


Recommendation:
