This letter refers to our conversation of November, 1983 concerning the proposed fence for the fastball diamond at McLean Park North East.

The Poco Mens Fastball League asked for quotes as per your specs from the following firms:

Trojan Fence - 1790 Kingsway, Pt. Coqt.
Raybern Erectors - 2300 Clarke St., Pt. Moody
Guard - All Fence - 115 Schoolhouse, Coquitlam, B.C.
Continental Steel - 251 Schoolhouse, Coquitlam, B.C.

The two firms interested were Raybern Erectors and Continental Steel and I am attaching their prices.

The Poco Mens Fastball League are willing to pay for and donate the fence to the City of Port Coquitlam on the condition that the City erect, dismantle, store and maintain the fence.

As mentioned by you, the City will request tenders for this job and we assume you will advise us of the final price.

If you require a down payment, please let us know, otherwise we presume that you will advise us how you wish payment.


This year we will be purchasing our own bases as well as two expensive liners, rakes and shovels for use by our League. For these we require a small storage area in one of the rooms under the grandstand, this can


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probably be arranged by removing one of the fences, account no longer required. As this equipment will be utilized solely by our League we would require a separate key and lock.

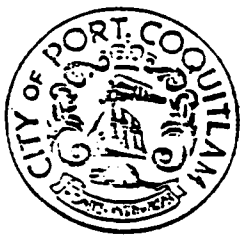

In the middle is an overlapping opening 3ft wide
The Endposts are 7.3 cm diameter 5' high
The lineposts are 4.7cm " 5' "
Toprail 4.1 cm "

All pipe to be schedule 40 galvanized steel pipe .Zinc not less than 1.6 oz.
per sq .ft of surface. As to ASTM standards.
Fabric: 1 1/2 " mesh, 9 gauge black plastified galvanized. 80,000 p.s.i tensil
strenght and 0.30 oz of zinc per sq ft.

Pipes are set in 2 ft oversized sleeves which remain in ground overwinter.
Should be supplied with aluminum cast caps (every sleeve)
End post to be supplied with caps also
Toprail is attached with steel 7 cast connectors
Hardware and ties standard.
Bottom has a 6 gauge electro galvanized wire
Pipes are set 8.ft apart.
