Steward, Princess Marguerite, Pier "B", Vancouver, B.C., on May 29th, 1939

and declare the result of the Analysis to be as follows: A member of the Staff of this Division

went to the farm supplying the above referred to Milk and Cream. He

supervised the milking operations; the sterilization of all utensils

used in the process, together with the final packing and sealing of

the containers. He then accompanied the delivery truck to the premises

of the Jersey Farms Limited, of this city. This man also supervised the

pasteurization of both the milk and cream. The pasteurized product was

then packaged and sealed under his direction. The whole operation, from

farm to pasteurizing plant was carried out under the most exacting sanitary

conditions.

On analysis the Milk and Cream were found to comply in every possible

way with the requirements of this Department. Both the Milk and Cream

was of excellent quality and safe for use for human consumption.

A member of the staff also supervised the pasteurization of the Cream

which entered into the manufacture of the Butter referred to above. All

equipment used in this connection was thoroughly sterilized before being

used.
