A member of the Staff of this Division went to the farm supplying
the above referred to milk and cream. He supervised the milking oper-
ations; the sterilization of all utensils used in the process, together
with the final packing and sealing of the containers. He then accom-
panied the delivery wagon to the premises of the Jersey Farms Limited
of this city. This man also supervised the pasteurization of both
the milk and cream. The pasteurized product was then packaged and
sealed under his direction. The whole operation, from farm to pasteur-
izing plant was carried out under the most exacting sanitary conditions.

On analysis, the Milk and Cream were found to comply in every respect
with the requirements of this Department. Both milk and cream were of
excellent quality and safe for use for human consumption.

The buttermilk also was prepared under the most exacting conditions,
the same precautions being used as in the case of the milk and cream.
This buttermilk was of excellent quality and safe for use for human
consumption.
