and declare the result of the Analysis to be as follows:

The City water used in the manufacture of these Ice Cubes,
was first examined and found to be of the purity required by the
City of Vancouver.

The equipment used in the freezing was carefully examined
prior to the manufacture of the ice and was found to be in a
clean and sanitary condition.

On completion of the freezing process, specially selected blocks
of ice were examined and set aside and the cubes were then cut from
the clearest portions of these selected blocks.

Finally, representative cubes of ice were examined and the
results of this analysis shows it to be of good quality and safe
for use for human consumption.

The complete processing operation was undertaken under the
personal supervision of an official of this Division.

The ice was packed under the most exacting sanitary conditions.
