S.S. Prince Robert, C.N. Dock, Vancouver, B.C., on May 29th, 1939

and declare the result of the Analysis to be as follows:

20 lbs. Fresh Extra Select Chicken Halibut - 2 only, 10 lb. Fish.

1 " " " " Herring, soft roe.

5 " " " " Sole Filets - 5 inches long.

1 " " " " Shrimp Meat.

The Halibut and Herring referred to above were firm, sound and
free from markings and disease. All were carefully packed in ice and
in boxes lined with Sterile Wax Paper.

The Filets of Sole were cut from fish of the best quality. This
operation was carried out under the supervision of a member of this
Division. These filets were packed in ice and the container lined with
Sterile Wax Paper.

A member of the staff of this Division accompanied the fishermen
and witnessed the catching, sorting, selection and cooking of the shrimps,
which was conducted in safe sea water and in specially sterilized
utensils. After the cooking process was completed the shrimp meat was
carefully packed into a new sterilized container. All the above fish
and fish products were found to be of
excellent quality, in good condition,
and safe for use for human consumption.
