TRAFFIC CONTROL - SEC.VI. MAY 29th, 1939.

Part 1

1. No vehicle to be allowed to stop; stand; or park, on line of route from 6.00 am to 1.00 pm as follows:

It shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle to stop; stand or park such vehicle in any of the following places, except when necessary to avoid conflict or collision with other traffic, or in compliance with the directions of any Police Officer, traffic sign or traffic control signal during the hours indicated on Monday, May 29th, 1939, that is to say: Between the hours of 6.00 am to 1.00 pm.

Both sides of Cordova St., from Richards St. to Granville St.
Both sides of Granville St. from Georgia St., to Cordova St.
Both sides of Georgia St. from Burrard to Hornby St.
Both sides of Hornby St. from Georgia to Robson St.
Both sides of Burrard St. from the South property line of the C.P.R. property to Pacific St.
Both sides of Burrard Bridge and the approaches thereto, between the south property line of Pacific St. and the north property line of 1st. Ave. and between the south property line of Pacific St. and Cornwall St.
Both sides of Burrard St. from 1st Ave. to 12th Ave.
Both sides of 12th Ave. from Burrard St. to Kingsway.
Both sides of Kingsway from 12th Ave. to Knight Rd.
Both sides of Knight Rd. from Kingsway to 41st Ave.
Both sides of 41st Ave. from Knight Rd. to Main St.
Both sides of Main St. from 41st Ave. to 33rd Ave.
Both sides of 33rd Ave. from Main St. to entrance of Little Mountain Park.
Both sides of Little Mountain Park Rd. from 33rd Ave. to Cambie St.
Both sides of Cambie St. from 29th Ave. to King Edward Ave.
Both sides of King Edward Ave. from Cambie St. to Osler Ave.
Both sides of Osler Ave. from King Edward Ave. to the Crescent.
Both sides of The Crescent.
Both sides of Angus Dr. from The Crescent to 41st Ave.
Both sides of 41st Ave. from Angus Dr. to Dunbar St.
Both sides of Dunbar St. from 41st Ave. to 16th Ave.
Both sides of 16th Ave. from Dunbar St. to Crown St.
Both sides of Crown St. from 16th Ave. to 10th Ave.
Both sides of 10th Ave. from Crown St. to University Lands at Blanca St.
Both sides of Marine Dr. N.W. from Westerly City Boundary to Sasamat St.
Both sides of Hadden Ave. from Sasamat St. to Imperial St.
Both sides of Imperial St. from Hadden Ave. to 4th Ave.
Both sides of 4th Ave. from Imperial St. to Alma Rd.
Both sides of Alma Rd. from 4th Ave. to Point Grey Rd.
Both sides of Point Grey Rd. from Alma Rd. to Trafalgar St.
Both sides of Cornwall St. from Trafalgar to Burrard Bridge south approach.
Both sides of Thurlow St. from Hastings St. to Pacific St.
(Thurlow St. is reserved for marshalling troops and Returned Men.)

Any automobiles parking on line of route contrary to this Bylaw are to be moved and summons applied for. If tow car is used, note to be made of same on Summons Sheet as costs will be asked for in Court.

2. Line of Route from C.P.R. Wharf to 12th Ave., and Main St. will be closed to through vehicular traffic from 8.00 am until Royal Procession has passed.

The portion of route from Burrard and Cornwall St. to Vancouver Hotel will remain closed until Royal Procession has returned.

3. Line of route from 12th Ave. & Main St. to 10th Ave. & Blanca St. and from Marine Dr. N.W. at Westerly City Boundary to Cornwall & Burrard St. will be closed to through vehicular traffic from 9.00 am until Royal Procession has passed.

4. Vancouver Auto Towing Trucks will be stationed on, and will patrol route as follows:

1 truck from C.P.R. to Burrard & 12th Ave.
1 truck from Burrard & 12th Ave. to 41st Ave. East.
1 truck from 41st Ave. East to Dunbar & 33rd Ave.
1 truck from Dunbar & 33rd Ave. to Cornwall & Burrard.
The trucks are available to remove any obstruction on route.

5. Street cars to be allowed to operate on route and to cross route until one (1) hour before Royal Procession passes. B.C.E.R. Inspectors will be stationed at all street car points on route and will stop street car service at time indicated.

Officers on duty at following points to keep street open and allow street cars and cross-traffic to operate until one (1) hour before Royal Procession passes:

Police Officers at above points to be provided by Sector Commanders.

6. Officer in charge at Cordova and Granville Sts. will note that the sailing of C.P.R. boat has been put back until 11.00 am; also departure of C.P.R. train until 11.00 am, and that as soon as Royal Procession has left C.P.R. Ramp at Burrard St., the intersection at Cordova and Granville Sts. is to be opened to allow passengers access to Boats and Trains.

7. City-bound traffic on Kingsway will be diverted north on Victoria Road at 8:45 am to 11:35 am. Special P.C. will be provided by Traffic Division.

South bound traffic on Kingsway will be diverted East at Broadway at 8.45 am to 11.35 am. Special P.C. will be provided by Traffic Division.

Burrard Bridge will be closed to both pedestrian and vehicular traffic at 8.00 am. All north bound vehicular traffic to use Granville or Cambie Bridges or Main St. Allotted groups only to be allowed to stand on Burrard Bridge.

8. Vancouver Hotel: Vancouver Hotel to be kept clear on Georgia Street from Burrard to Hornby St., and on Hornby St. from Georgia to Robson Sts.

Their Majesties will enter and leave Hotel by Burrard Street Entrance.

Guests for Civic Luncheon will enter Hotel by Hornby St. Entrance.
Cars of Guests to enter Hornby St. at Robson St.

9. CITY HALL: Cars of invited guests will be able to enter City Hall by way of intersection at Alberta and 11th Ave.

Officers on duty at this point to allow Invited Guests only to pass on production of official credentials.

10. Special Police Constables will be detailed for traffic duty outside of route area and will be in charge of Sgt. McKinnon, who will detail same for duty.

TRAFFIC CONTROL - SEC.VI. MAY 29th, 1939.

Part 2.

1. No vehicle to be allowed to stop; stand or park, on line of route from 12.00 noon to 5.00 pm as follows:

It shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle to stop, stand or park such vehicle in any of the following places, except when necessary to avoid conflict or collision with other traffic, or in compliance with the directions of any Police Officer, traffic sign or Traffic control signal during the hours indicated on Monday, May 29th, 1939, that is to say: Between the hours of 12.00 noon to 5.00 pm:

Both sides of Granville from Georgia to C.P.R. property line.
Both sides of Georgia St. from Chilco St. to Beatty St.
Both sides of Georgia Viaduct from Beatty St. to Main St.
Both sides of Main St. from Georgia Viaduct to Terminal Ave.
Both sides of Terminal Ave. to Grandview Viaduct.
Both sides of Grandview Viaduct.
Both sides of First Ave. from Clark Dr. to Victoria Dr.
Both sides of Victoria Dr. from 1st Ave. to Hastings St.
Both sides of Hastings St. from Victoria Dr. to Renfrew St.
Both sides of Renfrew St. from Hastings St. to Oxford St.
Both sides of Miller Dr. from Hastings St. to Windermere St.
Both sides of Windermere St. from Miller Dr. to Hastings St.
Both sides of Hastings St. from Windermere to Cassiar St.
Both sides of Cassiar St. from Hastings to the Bridgeway.
Both sides of Bridgeway from Cassiar to 2nd Narrows Bridge.

2. Line of route from Burrard St. Eastwards will be closed to through vehicular traffic from 1.00 pm until Royal Procession has passed.

The portion of route on Georgia St. from Vancouver Hotel to Granville St. will remain closed until Royal Procession has returned.

Georgia Street Viaduct to be closed to both pedestrian and vehicular traffic and all persons kept off same.

3. Line of route from First Narrows Bridge to C.P.R. Docks will be closed to vehicular traffic from 2.30 pm until Royal Procession has passed.

4. Stanley Park will be closed to vehicular traffic at 1.00 pm.

Police Officer to close same at Causeway and Chilco St., and officer to be provided by Sector Commander i/c Stanley Park.

5. Vancouver Auto Towing trucks will be stationed and patrol route as follows:

1 truck from Burrard to Main & Terminal Ave.
1 truck from Main & Terminal to Hastings & Nanaimo St.
1 truck from Hastings and Nanaimo to Second Narrows Bridge.

(then move to)

1 truck from First Narrows Bridge to Georgia & Pender St.
1 truck from Georgia & Pender to Burrard & Georgia St.
1 truck from Georgia & Burrard to Dunsmuir & Granville.
1 truck from Granville & Georgia to C.P.R.

The trucks are available to remove any obstruction on route.

6. Street cars to be allowed to operate on and cross route until one (1) hour before Royal Procession passes.

B.C.E.R. Inspectors will be stationed at all street car points on route and will stop street cars at time indicated.

Officers on duty at following points to keep street open and allow street cars and cross-traffic to operate until one (1) hour before Royal Procession passes:

Granville and Georgia
Richards and Georgia
Cambie and Georgia
Main and Georgia
Terminal and Main
Commercial and 1st Ave.
Hastings and Victoria
Hastings and Cassiar
Pender and Georgia
Pender and Granville
Granville and Georgia
Granville and Hastings.

Police Officers at above points to be provided by Sector Commanders.

7. Any automobiles parking on line of route contrary to this Bylaw are to be moved and summons applied for. If towing car is used, note to be made of same on Summons Sheet as costs will be asked for in Court.
