Sir:

With reference to the conversation which took place in your Office on October 22nd, 1938, concerning a letter written by H. H. Duggan and dated October 18th, 1934, which letter in question made mention of a certain Wing Ching case, and in which the said H. H. Duggan made certain false and slanderous statements concerning myself, I understand from you that Sergeant H. H. Duggan has now expressed a wish to apologize and retract in writing the statements referred to above, and admits them to be false, but fears that I might make use of such document to press an action for slander against the said H. H. Duggan.

This is to definitely state that with the delivery of such letter of apology and retraction to the Chief Constable, Col. W. W. Foster, or to myself, that I undertake to never use the letter referred to in any subsequent suit for libel and slander concerning this matter, and that I will consider the matter completely and finally closed.
