We command you and every of you that, all business being laid aside, and all excuses ceasing, you and every of you do in your proper persons appear before Our Justice of Oyer and Terminer and General Gaol Delivery, assigned to keep Our Peace at a General Court of Oyer and Terminer and General Gaol Delivery to be holden at *Vancouver*, in and for the County of *Vancouver*, on *Wednesday* the *6th* day of *October*, now next ensuing, at the hour of *10.30* eleven o'clock in the forenoon of the same day, to testify the truth, and give evidence on Our behalf against *P. J. Brennan* for *Manslaughter* and so from day to day during the sittings of said Court until the above cause is tried.

~~And also that you bring with you and produce at the time and place aforesaid~~

and this you and every of you are in nowise to omit, or any of you to omit, on pain of the penalty of One Hundred Dollars.
