DOLLAR PAYMENTS

The amount due to the Society is expressed in sterling. Fellows and Subscribers resident outside the sterling area can usually arrange for sterling payments to be made through their Bankers. Those, however, who find it more convenient to make small payments by means of cheques payable in dollars are requested to remit at the rate of \$2.80 = £1 (14 cents = 1/-d) and to add to each payment the sum of 25 cents. This addition is necessary to meet the Bankers charges deducted on conversion of each cheque and to cover the Society against loss through minor variations in the rate of exchange.

CURRENT CHEMICAL PAPERS—AIR MAIL EDITION.

From January 1955 Current Chemical Papers will be available to Fellows and Subscribers outside Europe in an edition printed on Air Mail paper at an **extra cost** of £2. 5s. 0d. Sterling (A£2 16s. 3d.) to cover the additional expenses of printing and postage. Fellows wishing to receive this edition should indicate their wishes on the form and include the payment with their remittance.

You are requested to complete the form given overleaf by indicating the publications and services you wish to receive in 1956. The annual subscription falls due on January 1st and it is essential that your requirements should be notified by that date to avoid delays in the despatch of publications. In view, however, of the amount of work involved in recording the subscriptions of Fellows it will be greatly appreciated if you are able to return the form **as soon as possible**.

The following notes will assist you in completing the form.

NOTES.

1. Annual Fellowship Subscription.

The annual subscription of £2 2s. 0d. (Two Pounds Two Shillings) is payable by all Fellows other than Life Fellows.

2. Publications.

You are entitled to purchase one copy of each of the publications listed, at the special Fellows' price (subject to your signature to the declaration on the form).

Please indicate, in column (d) overleaf, the publications you wish to receive in 1956. To assist you in making your selection, the publications you received in 1955 are shown in column (e). The cost of additional copies and of back numbers, will be quoted on application to the General Secretary.

If you are under 27 years of age on January 1st, 1956, you will receive the Annual Reports and Quarterly Reviews free of charge. Other publications may be purchased at the Fellows' price.

Fellows are reminded that publications are supplied to them for their personal use, at special rates, which in some cases barely cover the cost of printing and paper. For this reason Fellows are required to sign the declaration overleaf. Publications can only be supplied to Fellows at these rates so long as the Society is able to sell sufficient copies, at an economic price, to libraries and other institutions. It should be noted that libraries of charitable institutions may obtain a discount of ten per cent on the cost of public subscriptions if orders are placed directly with the Society.

3. Payments.

Complete the cash column (c) overleaf. The final figure will indicate the total sum due. This should be entered at B and forwarded to the Society's Bankers, **Messrs. Coutts & Co., 440, Strand, London, W.C.2, together with this form**. If, however, for any reason, it is impracticable for this form to accompany your payment then you are requested to send the form without delay, to The General Secretary, The Chemical Society, Burlington House, London, W.1., indicating how payment is being made.

Cheques etc., should be made payable to **"The Chemical Society, Fellowship Account,"** and crossed.
