Before requesting the Ambulance the Doctors are reminded that they should make arrangements with the Superintendent of the Hospital to admit the patients.

Any Physician requiring Diphtheria Antitoxin, Swabs, Culture Media or Vaccine, can obtain same by applying to the General Hospital, or to the Georgia Pharmacy.

Swabs, sputa, etc., for examination are to be sent to the Vancouver General Hospital, swabs should be sent in before 5:00 p.m., in order to obtain a report the next morning.

No quarantine for Diphtheria will be removed until at least two cultures from Nose and Throat have been reported negative by the City Bacteriologist, for which no charge will be made.

Infectious and Contagious Diseases And their Compulsory Notification to Health Officer

NOTE.—Physicians are required to **IMMEDIATELY** report, in writing, to the Health Officer, all cases of infectious and contagious diseases, the following diseases amongst others:—**Diphtheria, Scarlet Fever, Whooping Cough, Measles, German Measles, Mumps, Typhoid Fever, Chicken Pox, Smallpox, all forms of Tuberculosis, Acute Poliomyelitis, Epidemic Cerebro-Spinal Meningitis, and contagious Skin Diseases, etc**
