THIS IS THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT of me MARY EVELYN HOLT at present residing in North Vancouver British Columbia Canada.

1. I HEREBY REVOKE all Wills heretofore made by me and declare this to be my last Will and I further declare that my domicile is English and that I desire my Will to be construed and take effect according to English Law.

2. I APPOINT my niece Edith Emily Watson of 37 Selkirk Avenue Oldham England my nephew Frank Bradshaw of England and my nephew in law John Lees Watson of 39 Selkirk Avenue Oldham England Solicitor (hereinafter called my Trustees) Executors and Trustees of this my Will.

3. I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH all the residue of my real and personal estate and effects whatsoever and wheresoever unto my Trustees UPON TRUST that they shall sell call in and convert into money the same or such part thereof as shall not consist of money (with power to - postpone such sale calling in and conversion of any part of my estate and to retain any of my investments in the same state of investment as at my decease for so long as my Trustees shall in their absolute - discretion think fit without being personally liable or responsible for any loss occasioned by such postponement or retention AND shall with and out of the moneys produced thereby and my ready money pay my - funeral and testamentary expenses and debts and the legacies and the duties and incidental expenses chargeable on the legacies bequeathed by this my Will or any Codicil hereto AND shall invest the residue of the said moneys in any investments authorised by law in the case of trust moneys with power to vary such investments at discretion AND shall stand possessed of the said residuary trust moneys and the - investments thereof (hereinafter called "the residuary trust funds") UPON TRUST for such of them my four brothers Frank Holt Arthur John Holt Bernard James Holt and William Greenwood Holt and my sister Emily Bradshaw as shall be living at my death and the issue then living of such of them then dead (such issue taking his her or their deceased parents share equally) as shall attain or have attained the age of - twenty one years or previously marry to take if only one such object wholly and absolutely as tenants in common and per stirpes or -

according to the stocks if of more than one stock.

4. I HEREBY DECLARE that the said John Lees Watson shall act as Solicitor to my Executor or Executors Trustee or Trustees and that he (or any other Executor or Trustee hereof who shall be a Solicitor and shall do any legal or other work for the Executors or Trustees) shall be entitled to charge and to - receive and shall be paid the same remuneration for all - business done by him in or about the trust estate as he would have been entitled to charge and receive if he had not been an Executor and Trustee.
