Frank Holt

Born in Manchester - Eng Dec 2 - 1855 -

Arrived in Canada ^{June} 1883 aboard the Steamer
Parisian with 800 other immigrants -
Port Arthur. Ont.

Joined C.P.R. Construction Crew. and
helped Build Railway and Bridges - from
Chapleau - Ont. West.

Arrived on First train which landed at
Port Moody, B.C. then by Boat
(former Tanager. Side wheeller) to Vancouver.
Landing at Hastings ^{San} Mill.

Landed in Vancouver - July 1886.

Lived on Haro Street - in First Block off Burrard St.

{ Moved into present house located at rear of
Liberty parking and Service Station - 1025 W. Hastings

This house which originally consisted of 5 Rooms
was built in 1875 as a Boarding House
by the Spratt Cannery Co for their Cannery
Staff. The Cannery was located on the
north front to the west of Boarding House - the
Cannery was burned down in 1896. Four Rooms
of the Boarding House which encroached on City of
Vancouver land and was taxable were torn down
and the Room which stood on the C.P.R. right of way
was left standing - and this has been occupied

(The four Rooms were torn down in order to
give space to the parking station as well
as to build City Tavern with room for
standing happened to be on CPR right of
way, property -

Then one Room - the home of Mr. Holt
shed part way down the Bank from
onto the Railway tracks. Due to the
foundation giving way. It was hauled
back to the Bank again - and before
it was proper in position. Mr. Holt (who
was injured when it fell down (1 room)
shed part way down the Bank -) was
back and is again - he stood for years
to leave this place.

Mr. Holt's father was John Holt
Manchester 3rd
Druggist and Dispensing, and a
member of the Pharmaceutical Association of
Great Britain & Ireland -

There were 2 Brothers - Ben and Arthur
both dead - one sister dead - and one
other sister - Miss Mary Holt in Lynn Valley,
British Columbia - and a nephew - James Holt
Vancouver BC. In his earlier days Mr. Holt
was quite an athlete - and an outlandish foot ball player

and was one of the founders of George Church
Episcopal Boys - and under present Boys - at
