We have been gratified by the many kind comments which have come to us from the members of the Social Register of Canada Association since publication of the second edition.

It is felt that the addition of married children and summer residences to your entries has been of value and adds considerable interest. As, however, you were nominated to the Social Register, together with your immediate family, we feel that your married children and other adult children living away from home, are entitled to a separate listing in the Register as well as being incorporated in yours.
