

" MUNICIPAL SUPERANNUATION ACT "

VANCOUVER


The "Municipal Superannuation Act" provides that every person receiving an allowance must periodically inform the Commissioner of his whereabouts, either in person or by certificate, and furnish such other information as may be required.

Accordingly, it is essential that the enclosed form be completed in *full*. The signature(s) must be affixed and witnessed in accordance with the instructions (*see reverse side*).

If for any reason you are unable to have the form witnessed immediately, retain it until you are able to fulfil the requirement, *but* notify this office of the reason for delaying the return; otherwise your cheque cannot be issued.

Return the form when completed to the Superannuation Commissioner, Parliament Buildings, Victoria, B.C.

Signatures to be witnessed by a responsible person, such as a minister of religion, a medical practitioner, a bank manager, a Justice of the Peace, a Notary Public, or an employee of the Federal or Provincial Government, etc.
