Enclosed please find Cheque No. 1175-M for \$66.59, issued jointly to yourself and Mrs. Vance, and covering payment of the Retirement Annuity portion of your allowance for the period May 2nd to 31st.

On reference to Section 24(3) of the "Municipal Superannuation Act", copy of which was enclosed with our letter of the 12th ultimo, you will note that as your earnings from the City of Vancouver for May amounted to \$273.39, you were entitled to the Retirement Annuity portion only of your allowance for this month. The reduction of the Retirement Annuity from \$68.81 to \$66.59 is owing to the fact that your allowance became effective on May 2nd.

As we have been advised that your employment with the City terminated on May 25th, your full allowance of \$125.56 will be payable commencing this month, and a cheque will be mailed to you at the end of the month.

In order that any adjustments in your allowance cheques, due to re-employment, may be made currently, it would be appreciated if you would advise us direct any time that you should be employed by the City, or any other to whom the "Municipal Superannuation Act" applies.
