Re - Michael Ligne HESANABA alias HESENCY,
Murdered - Dawson, Yukon Terr.

Re the above, I am forwarding under separate cover, by registered mail, several pieces of cloth, cut from the clothing of a suspect in the above case, upon which are blood-stains. I would like to have same analysed to know if they are human blood.

The suspect, from whose clothing these stains were taken, was employed in a Butcher Shop, locally, as a meat cutter. The man who takes this parcel to the Dominion Analyst will have to be warned that he may be required to give evidence in this case.

Request the Dominion Analyst to wire me his findings, affirmative or negative. If it is human blood-stains, you had better warn him that he will be required as a witness and that these exhibits will have to be carefully guarded while same are in his possession and that he is to remain in possession of same until given further instructions regarding their disposition.
