chickens, to be despatched to Banff Springs Hotel,
Banff, Alberta. Chickens to be shipped on May 23rd, 1939.

and declare the result of the Analysis to be as follows:

A number of chickens were slaughtered in the
presence of a representative of this Division, and after examination
28 birds (weighing approximately 100 lbs.) were selected.

Further examination of the selected chickens
show them to be free from disease; of excellent quality; in good
condition and safe for use for human consumption. These chickens
were properly cooled, carefully handled and packed, and chilled
under most thorough sanitary conditions. They were packed into two
crates, each crate containing 14 birds.

Certificate of approval was issued to the Point
Grey Poultry Supply, for shipment purposes only.
