SPECIAL REPORT Re- Shipment Mushrooms from Money's
631 Seymour St. Vancouver.

Dear Sir:-

The following listed Foods were shipped to Banff Springs Hotel via C.P.R. express; this shipment was specially for the Royal party and they were given special inspection to assure as to purity and quality. A sample was submitted to your laboratory by myself on the morning of the day that the goods were shipped. Sample was taken at the warehouse of Money's Mushrooms upon delivery from mushroom beds, at 8.45 a.m. Sample delivered to Lab, at 9.10.a.m.

The shipment consisted of 32 boxes @ 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ # each in two crates. Select mushrooms.

Goods were packed in the most sanitary method for goods of this kind. All Mushrooms were specially picked, fresh, free of insect marks. Shipping crates were specially sealed and marked.
