Further to our letter of the 26th ultimo regarding
the visit of Their Majesties, the King and Queen.

We will require for the departure of the Royal Party
to Victoria on the SS "Princess Marguerite", two ribs of Grade A-1
beef, approximately 40 lb. average, which we would ask that you kindly
select specially. These ribs, of course, should be put away for
proper aging. Delivery is required on Monday, May 29th. While it is
realized this is a holiday we presume, in the circumstances, satisfactory
arrangements can be made to place same on the ship as desired.

We will, of course, require a Government certificate in
support of the Grade specified. It might be added that Mr. J.F.C.B. Vance,
City Analyst, has kindly consented to co-operate with us in connection
with all supplies and we would ask that he also be permitted to make his
inspection in order that we may secure a certificate from his Department.
