Copy of letter sent to Suppliers.

Dear Sirs:-

You probably know that Fruits and Vegetables grown in this Province and in California have to be constantly sprayed to kill bugs of all descriptions, and, although some sprays are not injurious to Human Beings others are very dangerous.

In the interests of this Railway catering to their patrons and in the interests of the Public generally I consider that all firms supplying fruits and vegetables should take every precaution to see that our Steamships, Hotels and Dining Cars are not furnished with fruits and vegetables that have been sprayed with anything that is injurious to human beings.

We, of course, are taking every precaution to have all fruits and vegetables thoroughly washed before using.
