Dear Sir:

I have been requested to undertake inspections and analyses of certain products in connection with the visit of Their Majesties to the City, and it occurred to me that your Company may require similar assistance and with this thought in mind I am placing at your disposal the services of the Staff of trained and qualified food inspectors and technicians of the Laboratory and Food Division for the purpose of inspection and analyses of foodstuffs which may be used by Their Majesties.

The Staff of this Division will lend every effort to hasten the work in order that City of Vancouver certificates of inspection and analyses may be issued at the earliest possible moment. This Division is also prepared to supervise the milking of dairy herds at the farm, and the supervision of the pasteurization of all such milk in a licensed dairy plant in this City, also the supervision of butter churning or any other food processing which may be required.

There is no charge whatever for this service, and I would like you to feel at liberty to make use of the services of this Division at any time you may have occasion to do so.
