Case of 'Joe Kozak'.

1 bottle is a one-pint beer bottle, and contains a liquid of a light brownish color, resembling beer in appearance and smell.

Bottle is full - new bottle, never having been previously opened.

2 'Rainier Special Beer' labels on bottle, and 'Rainier' cap, on bottle, written on large beer label is: - "J. J. B., J. K. L."

Small Manila cardboard tag tied on neck of bottle, written on it is: - "Evidence against Joe Kozak, Section 135 Indian Act, J. J. Bartlett, P.C. (150) Leatherdale."

The other bottle is a round bottle, and contains 7 ozs., of a liquid of a dark brown color resembling 'Rum' in appearance and smell.

Large 'Government Liquor Act' label on bottle, Printed on it is: -

"Government Liquor Act, Liquor Control Board, British Columbia, Demerara Rum, 35 O.P."

written on this label is: - "J. J. B." Part of 'Liquor Board Seal' on bottle.

plain cork in bottle, written on it is: - "J. J. B."

Small Manila cardboard tag tied on neck of bottle, written on it is: - "Evidence against Joe Kozak, Section 135 Indian Act, J. J. Bartlett, P.C. (150) Leatherdale"
