The bottle contains 7 ozs. of liquid of a yellowish color
and has a Sourish - sweet taste, and from appearance,
taste and smell, it appears to be a "Hard Cider".
There is a plain cork in neck of bottle, which is sealed
over with plain sealing Wax

There are 3 small gum labels on bottle, pasted together,
written on one is: - "J. M. C.",
written on the other: - "L. W. B.",
and on the other: - "TH"

There is also a letter received with the bottle, headed
"Office of Indian Agent,
Department of Indian Affairs Canada",
New Westminster, B.C.

signed by A. O'N. Daunt,
